Partners


*Work collaboratively with partners, to understand and address the root causes of violence in Avon and Somerset, with a focus on education, prevention, and protection.*

The below diagram outlines the framework to the strategy and how the three core priorities tie everything together. It sets out **9 key commitments** of the partnership, these provide the steer for our responses. **30 responses have been set out in the strategy** and will be developed by the Avon and Somerset Serious Violence Delivery group to put into action.

Over the course of 24-25, a plan will be put into place, led by the VRP Director. The progress of this plan will be regularly reviewed and reported on to the Serious Violence Reduction Partnership Board.
